

Textured Cowl



Use a soft heavy-worsted weight yarn to make this cowl. A little fuzz just adds to the fun!

Finished Sizes: 8" deep x 27" diameter (12" deep x 27" diameter/ 8" deep x 54" diameter). Changes, when needed, for deeper and longer sizes are shown in parentheses.

Materials: About 150 (200/300) yd. soft heavy worsted-weight yarn, size 9 24" (24"/32)" circular needle or the size that gives you the gauge below, and another 24" circular one size smaller, one stitch marker, yarn needle. Model in first size used 1 skein of Lang "Mia."

Gauge: 16 st = 4 inches in stockinette stitch on larger needle

Stitch Guide:

Garner Stitch in the round: Purl one round, knit one round.

Stockinette Stitch in the round: Knit every round

Seed Stitch: Round 1: *K1, p1; repeat from *.

Round 2: *P1, k1; repeat from *.

Slip Stitch I: Round 1: "P2, slip 2 purlwise with yarn in front; repeat from *.

Round 2: Knit.

Slip Stitch II: Round 1: *K2, slip 2 purlwise with yarn in front; repeat from *.

Round 2: Knit.

Instructions:

With smaller needle, cast on 108 (108/216) stitches. Join into round, being careful that stitches are not twisted around the needle. Place marker for beginning of round.

Beginning and ending with a purl round, work garner stitch for 5 (7/7) rounds.

Change to larger needles and begin textured patterns.

Rnds 1-4: Work stockinette stitch for 4 rounds.

*Rnds 5-12: Work seed stitch for 8 rounds.

Rnds 13-16: Work stockinette stitch for 4 rounds.

Rnds 17-20: Work slip stitch I for 4 rounds.

Rnd 21: Knit one round.

Rnds 22 -25: Work slip stitch II for 4 rounds.

Rnd 26: Knit one round.

Rnds 27-30: Work slip stitch I for 4 rounds.

Rnds 31-33: Knit three rounds.**

Repeat from * to ** 0 (1/0) times.

Work seed stitch for 8 rounds.

Work stockinette stitch for 4 rounds.

Change to smaller needle.

Beginning and ending with a purl round, work 5 (7/7) rounds in garner stitch.

Bind off **loosely**, holding larger needle in right hand.

Weave in ends. Block if necessary.
