

Textured Cowl



Use a soft heavy-worsted weight yarn to make this cowl. A little fuzz just adds to the fun!

Finished Size: 12" deep x 27" diameter

Materials: About 200 yd. soft heavy worsted-weight yarn, size 9 24" circular needle or the size that gives you the gauge below, and another 24" circular one size smaller, one stitch marker, yarn needle. Model used 2 skeins of Lang "Mia" a brushed alpaca blend.

Gauge: 16 st = 4 inches in stockinette stitch on larger needle

Stitch Guide:

Garner Stitch: Purl one round, knit one round.

Stockinette Stitch: Knit every round

Seed Stitch: Round 1: *K1, p1; repeat from *. Round 2: *P1, k1; repeat from *.

Slip Stitch I: Round 1: "P2, slip 2 with yarn in front; repeat from *. Round 2: Knit.

Slip Stitch II: Round 1: *K2, slip 2 with yarn in front; repeat from *. Round 2: Knit.

Instructions:

With smaller needle, cast on 108 stitches. Join into round, being careful that stitches are not twisted around the needle. Place marker for beginning of round.

Beginning and ending with a purl round, work garter stitch for 7 rounds.

Change to larger needles and work stockinette stitch for 4 rounds.

*Work seed stitch for 8 rounds.

Work stockinette stitch for 4 rounds.

Work slip stitch I for 4 rounds.

Knit one round.

Work slip stitch II for 4 rounds.

Knit one round.

Work slip stitch I for 4 rounds.

Knit three rounds.**

Repeat from * to ** once..

Work seed stitch for 8 rounds.

Work stockinette stitch for 4 rounds.

Change to smaller needle.

Beginning and ending with a purl round, work 7 rounds in garter stitch.

Bind off **loosely**, holding larger needle in right hand.

Weave in ends. Block if necessary.
