

## Thick & Thin Infinity Scarf

Fast, easy and luxurious, you'll want this cowl for all seasons.  
Try it in a pretty ribbon for spring and summer.

Materials: 2 skeins Plymouth Yarns Hacienda or 200 yd of similarly textured thick & thin bulky yarn. Size 11 and 15 circular needles, 29" long or longer. Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

With size 15 needle, cast on 110 st. Join into round, being careful that the stitches are not twisted around the needle. Place marker for beginning of round.

Change to size 11 needles.

Rnd 1: Knit

Rnd 2: Purl

Rnd 3: Knit

Rnd 4: Purl

\*\*Change to size 15 needle.

Rnd 5: \*K1, yarn-over (YO); repeat from \* around.

Rnd 6: \*K1, drop next YO off the left needle without knitting it; repeat from \* around.

Rnd 7: Repeat round 5

Rnd 8: Repeat round 6

Change to size 11 needle.

Rnd 9: Purl

Rnd 10: Knit

Rnd 11: Purl \*\*\*

Repeat from \*\* to \*\*\* twice more.

Bind off loosely with size 11 needles using this stretchy bindoff: Knit 2 stitches, \*insert tip of left needle through the front of the two stitches on the right needle and knit them together. Knit one more stitch, then repeat from \* to end. Cut yarn, pull through last stitch, weave in ends.
